

BRWF BREAKAWAY RULES

ROPINGS – Every roper must pay a 1x office fee \$35 per roper for this event. ALL ROPINGS TAKE PLACE IN THE OUTDOOR ARENA IN FRONT OF THE GRANSTANDS AT THE HEART OF OK EXPO (OUTDOORS) RAIN OR SHINE. (NOT COVERED)

NO REFUNDS AFTER ENTRY DEADLINE. REFUNDS ALLOWED THROUGH MAY 30, 2024 MINUS OFFICE FEE, CREDIT CARD FEE AND 10% OF ENTRY FEES
BREAKAWAY AND MATURITY ENTRIES MAY “SELL SPOTS” UNTIL START OF EVENT WITH VETERINARY RELEASE. HORSE SUBS ALLOWED IN EACH EVENT UNTIL START OF EVENT..

100 K CATTLE TAGS (3D BREAKAWAY)

Added Money: \$10,000 **Sponsor:** 100 K Cattle Tags (\$5,000 BRIF BONUS FOR ELIGIBLE HORSES - SEE BELOW)

Entry Fee: \$125/run (\$10 paid back 100% day money) (\$10 paid back 100% in bonus round) (\$1 per run to sgp entry system)

SIDEPOTS Adult (age 19-39) (youth 18 and under as of Jan 1) (senior 40+ as of Jan 1) \$30 run Sidepots CAN BE added on at the show office before you rope! BRIF BREEDERS' INCENTIVE BONUS \$5000 (BASED OFF OF YOUR FASTEST TIME IN THE 3D BREAKAWAY) MAKE SURE YOU OPT INTO THE BRIF SIDEPOT IF YOUR HORSE IS PAID INTO THIS BREEDER'S INCENTIVE. (2D FULL SEC SPLIT PAYOUT)

Awards: Buckles to division winners (each session 1d-3d)

Format: 1 header (entry limit 4x max) (daily payout 100% \$10 ef per session 3D full sec split) \$10 from every entry to the Bonus Round. \$1 from every entry to SGP entry system. The remaining entry fee is paid back 75% with 100% added money. Overall results will not be final until AFTER the last session ropes Sunday morning. Please allow for up to ONE HOUR for awards to be ready. OVERALL checks will be mailed. Day money checks and awards and overall awards should be picked up AT THE EVENT!

Overall Awards: Saddles 1d-3d champions, Awards through 3rd place each div.

Bonus Qualifier: (1-50 entries) Fastest two times advance to Bonus Roping on Sun, (51+ entries) Fastest four times advance to Bonus Roping on Sun. (A roper may only use a maximum of four Bonus Race qualifiers IN THE BREAKAWAY ROPING)

Max Entries: A roper may enter a maximum of FOUR times in this roping. (any combination of sessions)

Basset Performance Horses (BREAKAWAY FUTURITY)

Added Money: \$5,000 **Sponsor:** Bassett Performance Horses

Entry Fee: \$355 (30% ea go and 40% to average) 75% payback (2 header) Go Rounds 2D full sec split (average straight payback – no divisions)

Awards: BUCKLES

Qualifications: Registered Horses 5 & under (foaled 2019 or later) FIRST year of breakaway competition. Could not enter before Nov 15, 2024 in breakaway roping. Not eligible to enter Maturity. Futurity horses get ONE year to be a futurity horse.

Open to women ONLY and boys 14 & under as of Jan 1, 2024

12 & UNDER GIRLS BREAKAWAY AGE AS OF JAN 1, 2024

Added Money: \$1,000 **Sponsor:** Re-Vita+ CBD

Entry Fee: \$205 (30% ea go and 40% to average) 75% payback (2 header) (\$2/entry sgp)

Max Entries: A roper may enter 2x max (roper does NOT have to ride a different horse)

12 & UNDER BOYS BREAKAWAY AGE AS OF JAN 1, 2024

Added Money: \$1,000 **Sponsor:** Re-Vita+ CBD

Entry Fee: \$205 (30% ea go and 40% to average) 75% payback (2 header) (\$2/entry sgp)

Max Entries: A roper may enter 2x max (roper does NOT have to ride a different horse)

Bonus Breakaway *ROPER MUST QUALIFY FOR THIS ROPING

Added Money: \$5000 **SPONSOR:** BONUS RACE FINALS

Entry Fee: \$0 (office fee is only fee that must be paid) 1x per roper \$35 GUARANTEED TO PAY \$5000 TO FIRST (remainder of payout tba, based off of qualifying events and 3D breakaway events at the finals)

Open to women ONLY and boys 14 & under as of Jan 1, 2024 BY INVITATION ONLY. Any openings will be announced. MUST EARN QUALIFIER AT AN APPROVED EVENT TO BE ELIGIBLE TO ENTER THIS ROPING. The producer will add you to the entry list. Office fee must be paid by May 30, 2024.

Max Entries: A roper may qualify a max of 4 times for this roping. The 100 K Cattle Tags Roping is an ON-SITE qualifier

INVITATIONAL hi stakes BREAKAWAY

Added Money: \$5000 **SPONSOR:** Succeed Equine

Entry Fee: \$1000

Open to women ONLY and boys 14 & under as of Jan 1, 2024 BY INVITATION ONLY. Invites sent Mar 29. Deadline April 22. Any openings will be announced April 27. (25 max ropers) EVERYONE WILL ROPE IN THE FIRST ROUND AND TOP 16 WILL BE SEATED INTO THE TOURNAMENT – ALL OTHERS WILL ADVANCE TO THE CONSOATION ROUND. Champion (with 16 ropers) will win \$8564 Ropers that go out in the first round will rope in the consolation round, which is winner take all \$2030 (8 ropers will advance to this round) WITH 16 ROPERS: winners of round one will receive \$570.94, round 2 \$1141.88, round 3 \$2283.75, round 4 \$4567.5 (if both ropers in a bracket miss, they will rope until there is a qualified time). SUBSTITUTIONS ALLOWED UP UNTIL FRI 7 PM IN SHOW OFFICE.

R BAR B MEN'S BREAKAWAY 50+ SADDLE TO WINNER (this is to be entered on site) cash or cc only.

Added Money: \$1,000

Entry Fee: \$235

Awards: SADDLE TO CHAMPION!

THIS IS THE ONLY ROPING THAT WE WILL TAKE ON SITE MUST BE ENTERED BY 930 AM THURSDAY. THIS ROPING WILL FOLLOW THE AM 100K CATTLE TAGS 3D ROPING SESSION (APPROXIMATELY 10 AM)

Check the schedule – we will have some open jackpots (enter on site cash only) and some practice sessions TBA

Entry Fees MUST BE PAID WHEN YOU ENTER ON SGPEVENTS.NET (May 21 – May 30 midnight) WE DO NOT take late entries!

Stalls for this events are sold by the wee if you need a stall, a very limited number will be available. \$100-\$150 We will reserve a group for the breakaway ropers in each price range.

ALL HORSES ON THE GROUNDS OVERNIGHT MUST STALL. FAILURE TO FOLLOW THIS RULE MAY RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION. If the facility decides to allow tie outs that will be announced at a later date. RV should be reserved through the Heart Of Ok Expo.

GENERAL ROPING RULES

DRESSCODE: FULL WESTERN ATTIRE, long sleeved shirt OR short sleeved shirt with collar. (no sleeveless shirts), western hat and western boots required. Failure to be in dress code will result in DQ.

Barrier

A rope barrier and electric eye will be used. All score lengths will be subject to BRWF roping committee's approval. Two Timekeepers, a Field Judge, a Barrier Judge, and Spotter will be in the arena at all times. It is the roper's responsibility to make sure the flagger is in place and flag is up before nodding for calf.

Contestants should check in at the trade show welcome booth upon arrival to pick up their welcome bag AND COMPLETE A W9 FORM.

Draw order will be posted on sgpevents.net and stall assignments will be posted on

Full western dress is required by contestants to be inside the arena. Long sleeved shirt, western hat, and western boots.

Bell Collar Catch only. Bell collar catch is defined as any loop passing over the calf's head and slack is drawn around neck only. No other appendages of calf (i.e. front leg, tail, etc.) can be in loop when rope breaks from saddle horn. The rope must be drawn up around the neck with no extremities in the loop and in front of the tail head when string breaks. If any extremities are in the loop when the string breaks but then goes back around the neck of the calf it shall be a "no time".

Ropes must be tied to the saddle horn of contestant's saddle with nylon string at the VERY end of the rope. A cloth no shorter than six inches (6") must be tied to the end of the rope. String will be provided. Judge will check your rope to make sure it is tied on securely and properly as you check in at the holding area.

Only one (1) loop can be carried. A dropped loop counts as a contestant's thrown loop.

Rope must be released from the contestants hand to qualify for catch.

Contestant must pass thru barrier before loop is released. Contestant must be horseback when clock is stopped.

It is at the judges' discretion to give a rerun.

30 second time limit will be enforced. The arena out gate will remain open in the arena at all times. Time must be taken with calf in arena. If any part of calf has entered out gate, no time will be awarded. (should this rule be waived it will remain the same for the entire event).

Breaking the barrier will result in a 10 sec penalty. The Field Judge will flag the contestant when the rope breaks away from the saddle horn.

No time will incur if contestant breaks rope by hand or touches rope or string after catch is completed. Exception to above, is if rope dallies around the saddle horn. Contestant can ride forward to un-dally and then stop to allow rope to breakaway.

Contestant MUST BE in the designated waiting area (next to the BOX) when they are 2 away or they may be disqualified. Example: roper #1 is in the box, if you are roper #2 or #3 you MUST BE in the designated waiting area once that roper is in the box and check in with official. Failure to meet this deadline may result in disqualification. If roper does not meet waiting area check in deadlines, they may be given an automatic "no time". **Any horse that is unruly in the box and breaks the barrier once pulled more than 2x will be disqualified and forfeit their run. After 2x roper will be asked to leave the box and the calf will be turned out resulting in a "no time".**

Any rules not specifically covered in this document are at the discretion of the roping committee.

Stock Rules

*Calves will be a chute run and will NOT be numbered. Contestants must rope in drawn order. Nobody but hired help is allowed in the calf SORTING area. Anyone found manipulating the draw in any matter will be disqualified without refund AND banned from future events. A contestant may have their own pusher.

* No stock with horns will be used.
